BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Newton, Illinois, that 12-1-4
(B) of the Newton City Code is hereby amended to provide as follows:

12-1-4 RESIDENCY POLICY

(A) Local residency is a condition for employment. An employee shall become a
local resident within six months after being hired, and shall remain a local
resident while employed by the City. Violation of this policy shall result in
termination of employment.

(B) Local residency shall be defined as residing within the geographic
boundaries of Jasper County, Illinois.

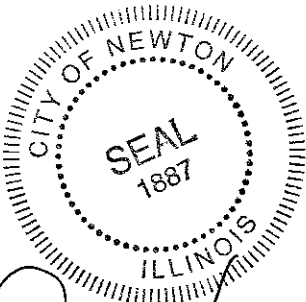
(C) No City-owned vehicle shall be permitted outside the City Limits of the City of
Newton, Illinois unless it is being used for official city business.

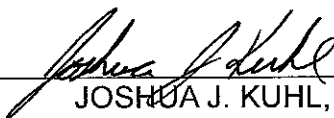
This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage,
